



BULLYOLOGY

Bullyology is a unique approach to identifying and preventing bullying. We have developed innovative methods to dealing with bullying by identifying effective techniques, efficient program delivery and a resourceful team approach. Our focus at Safe Futures is to help identify the issues around bullying and provide concrete strategies that will help in the prevention, assessment and intervention.

Bullyology for Students (Primary, Junior and Intermediate students)

Assembly style: One hour presentation in the library or gymnasium for one grade or 'division' at a time whenever possible.

Classroom presentation: One hour presentation to students in their classroom which allows for more questions and further exploration of strategies.

Additional presentation options: A full day of Bullyology presentations, one grade at a time, based on the school schedule. The best possible location for this type of day is in the library or gymnasium with students coming to the presentation at their scheduled time and sit on chairs.

Bullyology for Parents

A two hour presentation for parents to allow them to explore the issues related to bullying. The focus for parents is to identify signs that your child is a bully or a target, explore the important role of the bystander, and learn strategies to use at home. You will have the opportunity to have your questions answered and connect with other parents who are eager to share their knowledge.

Bullyology for school staff (Elementary school staff)

Lunch and Learn: Brief presentation about the Bullyology concept during a scheduled lunch at your school. This option also lends itself to a one hour session immediately following the school day.

Teachers, custodians, CYW's and office staff are all encouraged to participate in the session. You will learn to implement strategies and discuss their implementation as a team.
